
We are looking for a parent or two that would like to help on picture day. This job entails helping to organize classrooms to come down to the commons for pictures. It usually takes

#### MCKINNEY-VENTO ACT

Did you know that if you have become homeless or if any of the following circumstances apply to you or your child, your child may be eligible for support services from the school? The Act is meant to support children who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence:

- · Sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship,
- · Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, camping grounds due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations
- · Living in emergency or transitional shelters
- · Living in a public or private place not designed for humans to live.
- · Living in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations or similar settings, Migratory children living in above circumstances.
- · Awaiting foster care placement

#### SCHOOL COUNSELOR CORNER - MRS. KRESS

I love the beginning of the school year! Everything is fresh and new and most students have at least some level of excitement and positivity about being back in school and back in a routine. A positive outlook makes learning more likely and certainly more fun! For some students, when the newness of the year wears off; so does the positive outlook. Encouraging our students from a Growth Mindset standpoint can help to sustain their positivity, create perseverance and encourage a love of learning.

\*Growth Mindset\*: Belief that our most basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work—brains, talent and potential are just the starting point.

Fixed Mindset: Belief that our core personality, character, talent, abilities and intelligence are fixed. For instance, people might believe that they are either talented at something (art, music, sports, math, logic, etc.) or not; with no ability to grow or develop strength in that area.

Tips for Fostering a \*Growth Mindset\* at Home

· Praise Effort & Persistence

Offer praise to your child for hard work, perseverance, rising to a challenge and learning from mistakes rather than praising them for being "smart" or "naturally good" at something.

· Be a Growth Mindset Role Model

Pay attention to how often you say "I can't (cook/sing/draw, etc.)" or "I'm terrible at (sports/spelling/math, etc.)". It is important that our children see our imperfections and know that we are still working at some things, too. However, we want to offer an outlook of hope. Instead, add the word "yet" to your statement. "I'm not a good cook/singer/artist, YET but I am still learning!" or "I am still practicing sports/spelling/math." The things we say become the thoughts and internal voice of our children. Speak positivity!

· Encourage Mistakes

Most of the time we do not like to make mistakes. It takes time to correct them or we feel bad about ourselves for not getting it right the first time. However, mistakes are great!! Mistakes are a chance for learning and growth. Help your child see the benefits of their mistakes. After school, music classes or sports practices try asking your children what mistakes they made in practice and then what they learned from those mistakes and how they can use that new information or skill next time. This helps children to see that we don't expect them to be perfect or get everything right the first time and that mistakes are part of the process of learning!

Changing our mindset can be quite a challenge. If you're feeling like "This is tough. I do not have a growth mindset!"; remember all you have to do is add the word YET to the end of that sentence. You may not be thinking with a growth mindset YET but with practice and persistence you and your child will be on your way to a positive Growth Mindset!
