S.E. L. Lessons

This week, your child will practice a strategy called positive self-talk to help them reframe challenging situations. Ask your child to explain what "negativity bias" is. Share with each other one or more good things that happened today.

In next week's lesson to wrap up this unit, your child will share strategies for how to interrupt unhelpful thoughts and manage strong emotions with their peers by creating a comic strip.

Ask to see your child's comic strip. If they don't have the comic strip, ask them to explain it to you.

Curriculum Notes

ELA: We are continuing Bud, Not Buddy. Students will write a response to literature using evidence to support a claim to answer the question: Can kindness change a person's circumstances?

Social Studies: Students will be learning about how empires are governed, and will be exploring the many major empires of Era 3 including the Greeks, Persia, Rome, China and India. There will be a quiz over vocabulary for Chapter 4.
