Academically Speaking

In Language Arts, we are reading our class novel *Milkweed*. This book is about a young Jewish boy trying to survive in the Ghetto. Students have also been reading their small group novel. These books are all historical fiction. Students should be keeping up with the required reading and responses for their group book. In addition, students should be reading a book of their choice at home or throughout the day if they have time. Our hope is that students will find an additional 10-15 minutes during the school day and again at home to read their silent reading book. Silent reading book projects are due on the first day of each month. In addition to the grammar packets each week, students will also need to practice their spelling words and complete their spelling homework weekly.

In Science, we are practicing with balancing equations. In Social Studies, students are finishing their papers on the difference in viewpoints held by Thomas Jefferson and Alexander Hamilton.
