Fall Recess on Friday, October 23rd — that means No School!

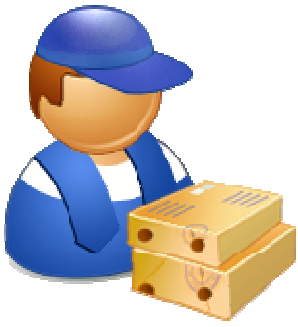

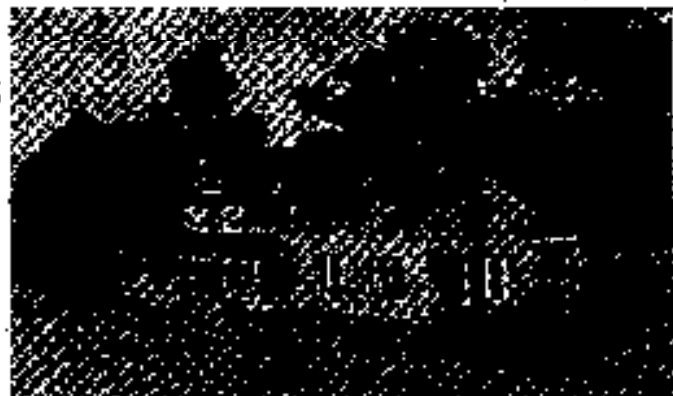
