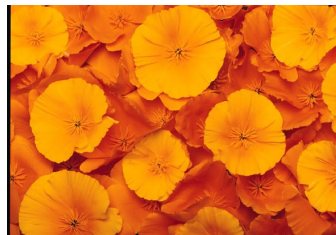
Curriculum Night: Thank you to all that came out to the curriculum night! It was wonderful meeting so many parents!
