The Chatfield School is currently hiring a Speech and Language Pathologist. The candidate will be responsible for impacting students within the Chatfield School K-8 program to improve speech and language skills.

Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Serve as an experienced educational specialist in the area of Speech and Language to provide best practices for Chatfield educators and families.
- Collaborate with school and ISD special education staff.
- Demonstrates understanding of students' needs, and interacts appropriately with students, parents, and staff.
- Demonstrates initiative and creativity with individual children and their program implementations.
- Write, facilitate and implement Individual Education Plans (IEP) that are in compliance and remain in compliance with all State and Federal rules and regulations that govern Special Education.
- Communicate with school staff and parents regarding student progress.
- Develop and maintain special education records; write timely reports when needed
- Participate in and utilize information gained in professional development.
- Schedule, plan and lead Individual Education Plan meetings.

Qualifications include:

- Master's degree in Speech and Language Pathology, a valid State of Michigan Speech-Language Pathologist license and Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology (CCC-SLP) from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA).
- Experience, knowledge and ability to plan, organize, and provide diagnostic services and therapy for children with speech, hearing, and language disabilities; to demonstrate, teach, and instruct students in language and speech development processes; to perform diagnostic assessments in determining speech and language performance levels; to aid in the development of academic, social, behavioral, and other educational skill areas; and to do other related functions as required. Follow all state and federal laws and regulations related to special education.
- Ability and desire to work collaboratively in an innovative, team-teaching setting.
- Ability to relate positively with students, colleagues, and parents.
- High level of interpersonal skills to communicate verbally and in writing.
