

Supplies	See the attached <i>Back To School Shopping List</i> .
Lunch	Your child will need to bring a nutritious lunch to school daily or purchase a hot lunch. Chocolate and white milk are available.
Snack	We are asking each child to bring his or her own morning snack each day. When considering what to pack, please choose things that can be eaten quickly and with minimal mess. We do not provide snacks to students who forget. The office will NOT supply snack. If you would like to send in a large box of snacks to be distributed at snack time, we will gladly do that for your child. <u>We want to discourage UNHEALTHY choices like cookies, candy, etc.</u>
Beverages	Until we are instructed otherwise, drinking fountains will not be used. If you would like, your child can bring in a labeled water bottle for personal use. We will expect that water bottles will be taken home on Fridays for a thorough cleaning.
Homework Folder	Students will be bringing a homework folder home <u>EACH NIGHT</u> . It is the expectation that parents will check the folder and review homework and correspondence from school. Please help your child develop the skill of responsibility by returning the folder <u>EVERY DAY!</u>
Outdoor Play	<u>All children</u> will be going outdoors for learning experiences and/or recess every day unless they have a written doctor's excuse. Please dress your child appropriately for the weather.
Transportation	Lower EI students and their siblings are picked up at the Dolphin Area. <u>You must provide a note if there are any changes in the normal routine.</u> We will only release your child to you or persons you designate in written form.
Birthdays	Coordinate with homeroom teacher if you would like to bring in a birthday snack. <u>Please do not send in or pass out birthday party invitations in the classroom areas.</u> Please contact parents on your own to deliver invitations.
Field Studies	We schedule field studies periodically throughout the year. You are welcome to join us. Siblings may or may not be allowed depending on the field study. Parent volunteers transport children need to fill out a <u>parent volunteer application</u> prior to driving. The application will remain on file for the year. <u>Students must ride in a car seat until they are 8 years old or 4'9" (whichever happens first), so car seats must be provided on field study days.</u>
Communication	We will be sending home a weekly newsletter. There is also a website; www.chatfieldschool.org that will have information posted throughout the year. If you have any needs or concerns, we will be happy to talk with you in person, on the phone or via email. <u>Our assistants are wonderful para-educators, but any questions concerning your child's objectives or progress should be addressed to his or her homeroom teacher.</u>
