In the Classroom...

MATH: Please check over your child's math assignments each night.

LITERACY: Students will complete a performance task based on skills they have learned in Unit Three. We will be guiding them through answering questions using text details to support their response. There will not be a spelling test this week.

WRITING: We will review the features of a persuasive essay this week. Students will then continue drafting their persuasive essay about whether a cat or dog makes the best pet. Students are expected to have their rough draft finished on Wednesday and will be bringing it home to be edited.

SCIENCE: This week students will be putting together their science fair presentation with their team by either creating a Google Presentation or a Science Board. Students will also write a conclusion based on their data and results.
