\*Independent Reading - Complete at least one plot graph for our reading challenge. Students should aim to read for at least 30 minutes each day. Many students are excited to complete multiple plot graphs for the challenge :)

\* Math - Mrs. Bierbusse and Mrs. Wolinski did provide their math students with a math packet that should be completed before April 6th. If students were absent on Friday, March 13th, the packet will be e-mailed to students. If you don't have access to a printer, students can complete the assignment in their notebook or on lined paper.
