S.E.L. Lessons

In this week's lesson, your child will learn how to listen to and consider someone else's perspective during a conflict. In next week's lesson, your child will learn how to describe a conflict in a non-judgmental way by avoiding blaming language.

*Discuss with your child a time in your life when your view of a conflict changed because you were able to see it from another person's perspective. Ask your child if they have changed their view about a conflict lately.

Curriculum Notes

ELA: Students will begin reading their author study novels by E.L. Konigsburg, and will be continuing their work on their Problem-Solution Essay. They will also conclude Chapter 3 in their grammar workbook on verbs.

Social Studies: Students will learn about how trade integrated cultures and influenced the economy within early African empires. They will also learn about the culture and economy of Indigenous Peoples in the Americas prior to 1500. There will be a vocabulary test over Unit 4 Section 6 on Friday, March 15th. Students have a review for this test to study.

Science: We will use the organelle posters students created to hold the Organelle Trail Round Up. Students will make analogies between organelle functions and jobs in a small town. Then we will move on to the building blocks of cells: macromolecules.
