Curriculum Notes

ELA: This week, we will continue working on reading strategies for informational text. Students are reading mystery novels and meeting weekly with their book club group to discuss their predictions, connections, and questions about what they have read.

Social Studies: Students are learning about world religions. Students are learning about how religions grew throughout the empires. There will be a quiz on Friday.

Science: This week, groups will test their redesigned penguin houses to see if they can improve on their design. They will analyze the data to determine which materials and construction decisions were most effective. The unit test will be on Thursday; students are allowed to use their notebooks.

Second Step Lessons
