## Curriculum Notes

**ELA:** In May, we will read *Out of the Dust*, a novel written in verse about the Dust Bowl. In writing, students will read and write poetry. To finish up the poetry unit, we will have a poetry cafe where students will read aloud at least one of their poems.

**Social Studies:** This week in Social Studies, students will be learning about the Mackinaw Bridge, including when it was built and why it is an important part of Michigan history and transportation. Students will also be creating a replica drawing of the bridge as part of the lesson activities.

When we return from Mackinaw, students will begin reviewing and preparing for final exams. Students will be allowed to use one sheet of notes (front and back) during the exam.
