## Mid Term Exams

Students will take midterm exams on Wednesday, January 22 (ELA and Science) and Thursday, January 23 (Social Studies and Math). The exams will assess students knowledge and understanding of concepts taught over the course of Semester One (Marking Periods One and Two). Sixth graders have received and reviewed strategies for properly preparing for an exam. All classwork and previous class tests will be especially helpful for reviewing class content.

Today, students received a study guide for both Science and Social Studies. They may develop a "notes page" for each midterm, so long as the notes are handwritten on one lined piece of paper. They may record notes on both sides of the piece of paper.

There is no study guide for ELA. Our writing exam will assess students understanding of composing an argument paragraph and skills studied while completing our grammar and language review and other grammar lessons. The reading portion will assess various reading comprehension strategies practiced during the school year.
