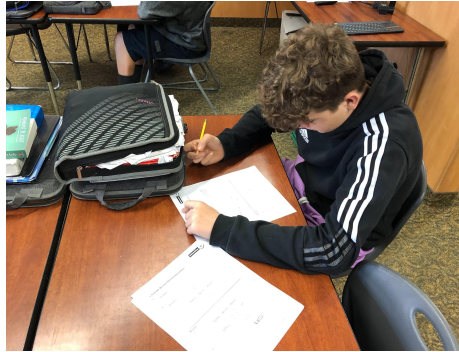

## Curriculum Notes

**ELA:** Students will be reading *Out of the Dust* by Karen Hesse. This will be done as a classroom read-aloud. Students will be working on a digital assignment connecting to comprehension and vocabulary with the story. They will be expected to keep up with the assignment as we are reading the book. We will learn about reading and writing poetry. Students will write several poems, and prepare to read at least one aloud at our Poetry Cafe on the last day of school.

**Social Studies:** Students will be identifying a significant issue that is still plaguing the world today, research the issue through several articles, and come up with some solutions to these issues. Students will also begin research for their Pure Michigan Study.

**Science:** This week, we will begin our study of human body systems. Students will learn about division of labor as it applies to cells, organs, and systems. They will look at how body systems work together in multicellular organisms to stay alive.
